When she physically recovered she channelled her own grief and anger into working with other families " ...I was in a place where I had capacity to act as a voice for those people."

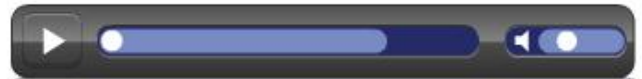
